# Alphabet Photography

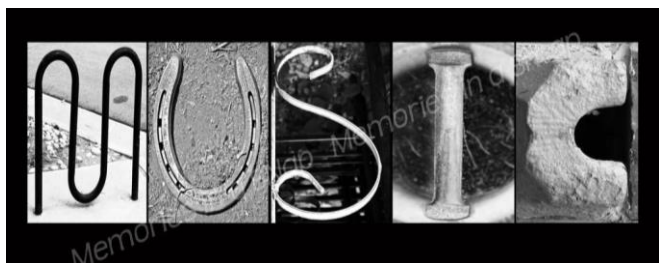
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## 4TH GRADE E-LEARNING ART

**Materials:** Chromebook, Smartphone, or Digital Camera

**Directions:** Check out these examples of Alphabet Photography:

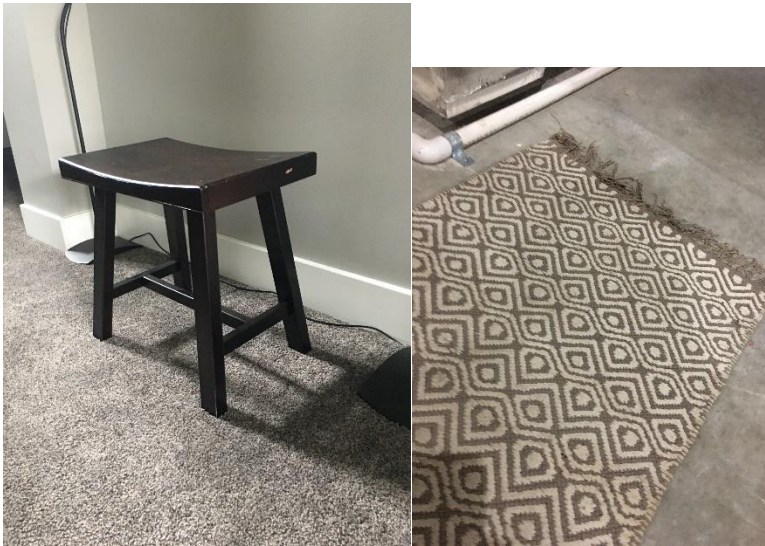
Do you see Letters? Do you see words?



Art is all around us – and so is the ALPHABET. Can you take photographs that spell your initials? What about your name? A word? Maybe the WHOLE alphabet?

I know that aiming the camera with a Chromebook is difficult – Do your best. Follow the direction sheet to find out how you can fix the picture, crop it, and edit your photos so that you can put photographs together to spell.

1. Look around your house or outside– try to find a letter



2. Get set, make sure you can fit the whole letter in the picture- you can always crop or zoom in later (the stool looks like an A to me and the rug looks like an O)



3. When you have finished taking pictures we will edit them

4. Open up Google Docs
5. Click BLANK doc
6. Type your NAME, and what your WORD is at the top of the page

7. Go to FILE – Page Setup –

Select Landscape

Change the size of your paper to “Tabloid 11x17” to make it longer/wider

8. INSERT – Table – Highlight as many boxes as you will need for your word
9. Get your cursor in the first box of the table
10. INSERT- Image – Upload from computer – find your picture – select it – click open
11. CROP – Move your black corners where you want them
12. Drag and Resize – Click on the image again to get the blue dots. Drag the corner to resize the image in the table box
13. Color or Contrast changes:  
IMAGE OPTIONS – Recolor – Select whatever you want, or Greyscale is Black/White

ADJUSTMENT – Change Brightness and Contrast to make the light parts Lighter or Dark parts – DARKER
