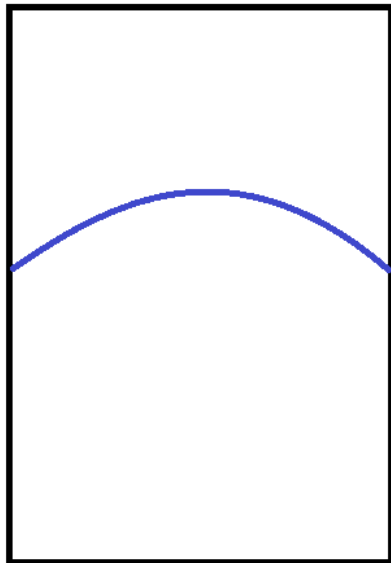

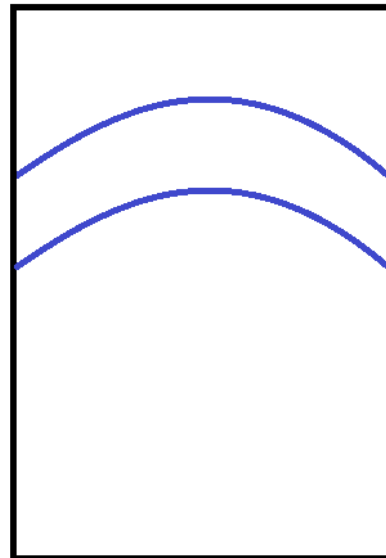

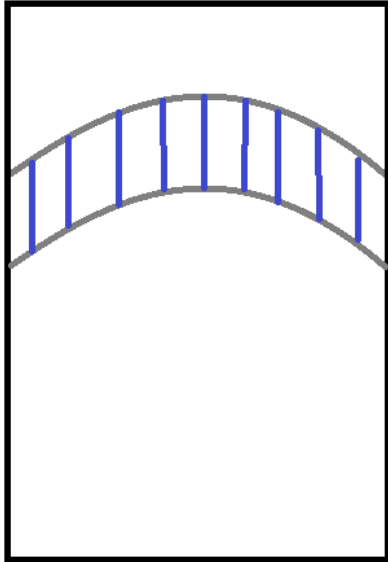
1. Turn the paper Vertical/ TALL.
Draw a curve in the middle of your paper



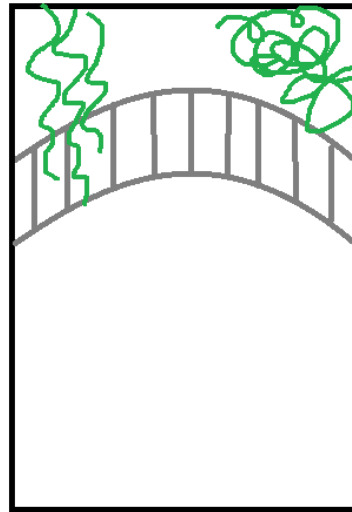
2. Skip some space and make another curve on top. This will be the bridge



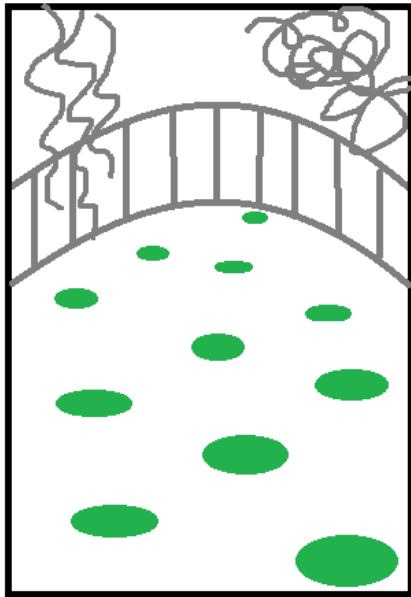
3. Draw Straight Vertical lines (up and down) across the bridge



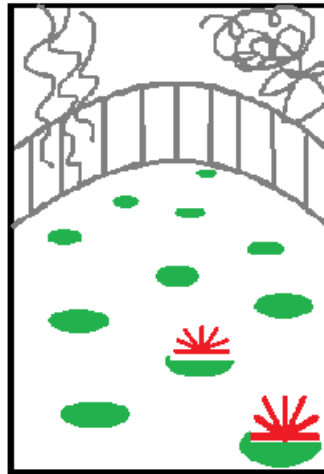
4. Draw some Vines (WAVY lines)
Or some tree leaves (Loopy Scribbles)
YOU PICK!



5. Make some lily pads – Draw small ovals closer to the bridge then bigger and bigger when you get to the bottom of the paper.



6. Draw some waterlily flowers on top.
Like this:



7. Add Grass along the slides on the bottom.

8. You can paint the water with watercolor paint, OR WATER-down paint, or Water with blue food coloring.
OR you can color it with crayons!
