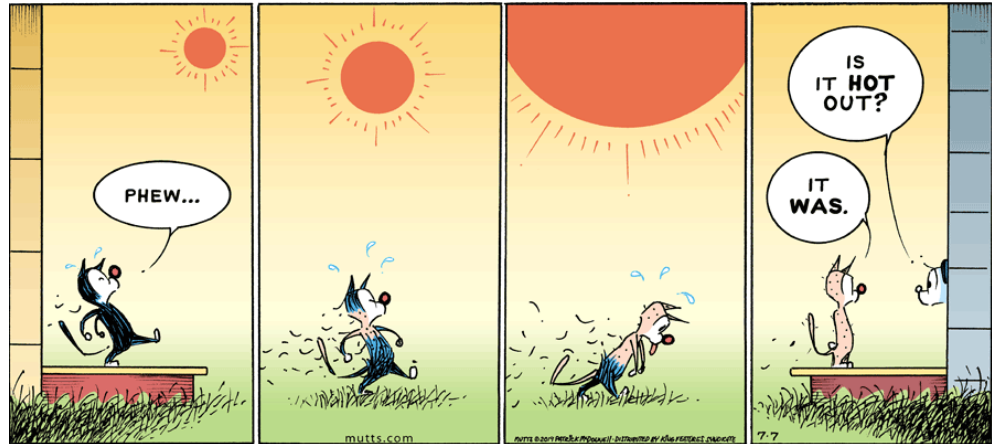


Comic Strip

Square #1: Introduction of Characters and place.	Square #2: What are they doing	Square #3: A problem
Square #4: Problem continued, problem creates other issues	Square #5: Solution/Figuring it out	Square #6: The End
