Drug Any substance, other than food, when taken changes the way you think or feel.

Medicine drug used to prevent, treat, or cure an illness or pain

Side effect an unwanted result of using a medicine

addicted having a strong habit that is hard to give up

antibiotic Chemical that destroys or weakens disease-causing bacteria.

depressant a drug that slows down the nervous system and decreases the rate of certain brain functions

inhalant substance whose fumes are sniffed and inhaled to get high

over the counter medicine a medicine that can be bought without a doctor's order; bought from the store.

prescription medicine A legal drug available with a written order from a physician (doctor).

stimulant A drug that speeds up the nervous system and other body systems.

tolerance With many drugs, you need to take more of the drug to get the same effect

withdrawal what occurs when the drug abuser stops using the drug they are addicted to.
