Dear Parent and/or Guardian,

All students entering an Illinois school for the first time are **required** by the State of Illinois to have a completed physical exam form and immunization record submitted to the health office no later than thirty days after the first day of school with East Maine School District 63.

Additionally, a completed eye exam form is required for all students, due May 15 of the school year. A completed dental exam form is required for students entering kindergarten, second and sixth grade.

Please make sure your doctor uses the Illinois physical exam form (rev. 11/2015), which has two pages. The back of the physical exam form includes the lead screening, tuberculosis screening, and diabetic screening and is completed by a health care provider. The medical history is located at the top of the back of the form and is completed and signed by the parent/guardian.

A Tdap immunization is required for all incoming 6th- 8th grade students. A second Varicella immunization is required for all incoming grade levels. One dose of the Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine is required at entry to 6th grade.

Proof of the following immunizations must be included on the physical exam form.

Diphtheria 4 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Measles 2 doses, given after 1 st birthday
Pertussis 4 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Mumps 2 doses after 1 st birthday
Tetanus 4 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Rubella 2 doses after 1 st birthday
Polio 3 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Varicella 2 doses after 1 st birthday
Hepatitis B 3 doses at proper intervals	Tdap 1 dose at entry to 6 th grade
Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine 1 dose at entry to 6 th grade	

Incomplete forms with missing required documentation will not be accepted and will be returned to the parent/guardian for completion. Always keep a copy of your child's medical records at home. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the health office.

A child that does not have the completed physical exam form and immunization record on file in the health office no later than thirty days after student's first day of school with East Maine School District 63 will be excluded from school.
