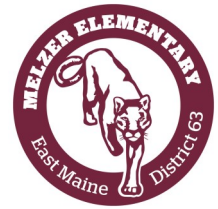

Student safety is very important, especially during arrival and dismissal. We have many students being dropped off and picked up, as well as walking and riding their bikes. We need everyone's help to ensure that we can keep this time safe.

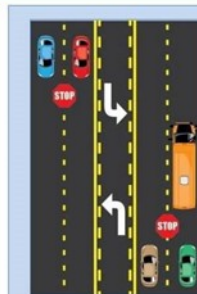
You can help us by:

- Follow bus stop signs. Oriole is a two lane road, which means that ALL vehicles (even ones that are parking) must stop moving.
- Park on the side streets. There is no standing or parking in the bus lane or in the turn around. Pull your car up as far as you can and have your child exit on the passenger side of the car.
- Use crosswalks. Students should cross in the marked crosswalks with crossing guards.

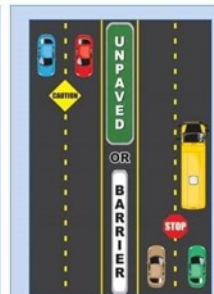
## What is the Law?



**TWO LANE**  
Vehicles traveling  
in both directions  
MUST STOP.



**MULTI-LANE - Paved Across**  
Vehicles traveling in both directions  
MUST STOP.



**DIVIDED HIGHWAY - With dirt, grass  
or barrier median - Vehicles behind  
MUST STOP. Vehicles traveling in  
opposite direction must use caution.**

The Morton Grove Police Department will be outside periodically to help us enforce our parking and traffic signs. They will issue citations for cars that are not following traffic laws, including cell phone laws. As a reminder, school zones in Illinois are cell phone free zones.

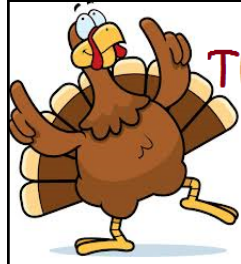
