Dear Parent/Guardian,

All students entering an Illinois school for the first time in grades 1st – 8th are **required** by the State of Illinois to have a completed Certificate of Child Health Examination form including the immunization portion submitted to the nurse’s office no later than thirty days after their first day of school with East Maine School District 63.

In addition, a completed Eye Examination Report is required for all students. A completed Dental Examination form is required for students entering kindergarten, second and sixth grade. Both forms are due by May of the current school year.

Please make sure your doctor uses the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form (rev. 11/2015), which has two pages. This includes the Diabetes Screening, Lead Risk Questionnaire, and the Tuberculosis screening, which will be completed by the health care provider. The medical history is located at the top of the back of the form and is completed and signed by the parent/guardian.

A Tdap immunization is required for all incoming 6th – 8th grade students. A second Varicella immunization is required for all incoming grade levels. One dose of the Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine is required at entry to 6th, 7th or 8th grades.

Proof of the following immunizations must be included on the Health Examination form:

Diphtheria 3 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Rubella 2 doses after 1 st birthday
Pertussis 3 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Varicella 2 doses after 1 st birthday
Tetanus 3 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Hepatitis B 3 doses at proper intervals
Polio 3 doses, last one after 4 th birthday	Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine 1 dose at entry to 6th, 7th or 8th grade after the 11th birthday
Measles 2 doses, given after 1 st birthday	Tdap 1 dose at entry to 6th, 7th, or 8th grade regardless of interval since last DTaP or Tdap
Mumps 2 doses after 1 st birthday	

A child that does not have the **completed Certificate of Child Health Examination form** including the **immunization portion** on file in the nurse’s office **no later than thirty days after student’s first day of school with East Maine School District 63 will be excluded from school.** Notes from doctors with appointment dates after thirty days of school will not be accepted.

Always keep a copy of your child’s medical records at home.
